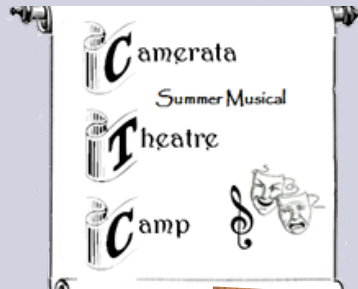


PRODUCTION NIGHT!
